The Commission recommendations to be implemented are the following:

- The task list and the timing of the tasks for the remaining two years should be updated and included it in the next periodic management report.
- When fully deployed the ViBANT infrastructure will have the potential to become a crucial node in the overall e-infrastructure for biodiversity data.
